1. FOLLOWING the demonetisation drive in 2016, more people began using credit or debit cards to make payments. It is a move towards a cashless economy.
2. In a credit card transaction, the main players are the credit card user, the merchant (shopkeeper), the acquiring bank (merchant's bank which provides the credit card machine), the issuing bank that issues the card to the user and the card association (MasterCard/Visa).
3. Typically, a customer hands over his credit card to the shopkeeper to pay for the goods. The shopkeeper inserts the card in a machine that captures information stored in the card's magnetic strip like the card holder's name, card number, date of expiry of the card, etc. as well as details of the shopkeeper's establishment and transaction amount. The cardholder has to key in a Personal Identification Number (PIN) to complete the transaction. The PIN enhances the security of the card and prevents fraud. The information is transmitted to the card-issuing bank for authentication via a telephone line or wireless Internet. Once the transaction is verified, the machine prints two receipts, one for the merchant and the other for the buyer. All this processing takes only a few seconds.
4. When the shopkeeper submits his receipt to the acquiring bank, the bank pays him the due amount. The acquirer recovers the amount from the issuing bank which in turn sends the user a credit card statement. The user has to repay the amount to the issuing bank within a stipulated time or else a fine is imposed. The job of the card associations is to regulate transaction fees, memberships and mediate between issuing and acquiring banks.

EATING out can be a delightful experience but if you're going to a classy restaurant or a five-star hotel, don't be caught on the wrong foot, or with the wrong fork! Here are some basic rules:

1. Dress appropriately. A formal meal at a five-star hotel requires one to be attired in traditional or western clothes. No casual clothes please!
2. When you enter the restaurant, wait for the hostess to escort you to your table. There'll be a napkin on the table. Never tuck it under your chin. That's only for babies! Large napkins, also called serviettes can be half opened and placed neatly on the lap. Smaller ones can be opened fully and spread on the lap.
3. It is generally the host who places the order after finding out what everybody wants.
4. Drinks should be sipped and never gulped. But if you have bitten something pungent and spicy, go ahead and drink large quantities of water. If your drink has a stirrer with a cherry on top, eat the cherry, stir your drink and then place the stirrer on the side plate and not directly on the table.
5. On the table, you will find the forks placed on the left, spoons and knives on the right and cutlery for the sweet dish above the plate. Start from the outermost cutlery to the innermost.
6. Soup is eaten, never drunk. Fill the spoon with soup, moving the handle away from you, and drink it from the side facing you. To get the last bit of soup into your spoon, tilt the bowl away from you.

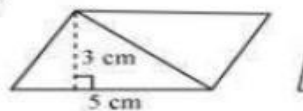
